Making Zac instructions

You will need:

- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Sticky tape
- Pencil
- Ruler

Step 1: Separate all the parts of your character by cutting out each shape along the blue dotted lines on your A4 piece of paper or cardboard.

Step 2: Slowly and carefully cut around each of the shapes along the grey solid outside lines.

Step 3: Starting with the head, use a ruler to fold along each of the dotted lines. Before applying glue, check to see that your box meets up neatly to create a cube.

Using a glue stick, apply glue to the white tabs.

Carefully press each of the tabs to secure them in place, to create a cube.

Put aside to dry.

Step 4: Next, take the body template and repeat the above process using a ruler to fold along each of the dotted lines, ensuring each of the white tabs are folded in.

Using a glue stick, apply glue to the white tab on the side of the body, then to the top tabs, finishing with the base.

Carefully press each of the tabs to secure them.

Step 5: Apply glue to the bottom of the body and attach to the display base, as shown.

Step 6: Next, apply glue to the top of the body and secure the head in place.

Step 7: Fold the shoe template along the dotted lines. Apply glue to the back of the template and secure to the front of the body at the base, as shown.

Step 8: Choose two arms for your character. Fold the white tabs at the end of each arm, apply glue and secure in place.

Step 9: To finish your character, bend the top of the hair template lengthways around a pencil, apply glue and attach to the front of the head as shown.

- Tips:**
- Ensure you apply a generous amount of glue to each of the tabs.
 - If you are having trouble securing the pieces with glue, use a piece of sticky tape to secure in place.
